*2 CUPS WHEAT, CORN AND RICE MIX*

*1 CUP EACH PRETZELS, CHEDDAR CHEESE CRACKERS (FISH)*

*1-2 CUPS SALTED NUTS*

*3/8 TO 1/2 CUPS BUTTER*

*3 TABLESPOONS WORCHESTERHIRE SAUSE*

*TEASPOON OF TABASCO; 2 TO 3 MILD, 4 TO 5 HOT, 6 TO 7 EVEN HOTTER*

*MELT BUTTER AND WORCESTER SAUSE AND TOBASCO TOGETHER IN MIRCO*

*MIX DRY ITEMS AND ADD 1/2 TO 1 FULL TEASPOON GARLIC POWDER*

*EVENLY MIX IN AND POUR BUTTER SAUCE OVER DRY ITEMS MIX BY ADDING 1/4 MIX*

*AND M IX IN 1/4 AGAIN AND MIX IN 1/4 AGAIN THEN ADD THE LAST PORTION AND MIX*

*AGAIN.*

*MICROWAVE FOR 2 MINUTES ON HIGH, MIX THIS MIXTURE,*

*MICROWAVE FOR 2 MORE MINUTES ON HIGH MIX THIS MIXTURE*

*ADD 1 CUP OF PLAIN CHERRIOS, MIX AND MICROWAVE FOR 2 MINUTES ON HIGH,*
