FOR YOU RUSTY OLD BOLT AND NUT CAR GUYS AND GALS.

Penetrating oil comes in a number of products and prices. Some work better than others, from good to not so good. The test is torque required to remove the rested fastener, check out these results.

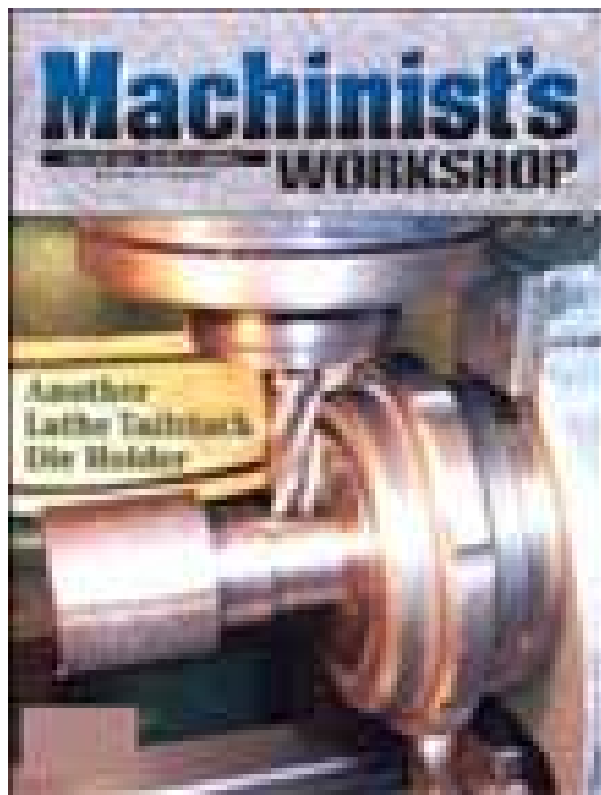
No oil, 516 pounds

WD-40, 238 pounds

PB Blaster, 214 pounds Liquid Wrench, 127 pounds Kano Kroil, 106 pounds

ATF (automatic transmission fluid) I Acetone mix, 53 pounds

ATF I Acetone mix is a home brew mixture of 50-50. This mixture appears to be the best overall and cost pennies to mix up. You can substitute lacquer thinner for the Acetone, this is a safer mixture.
